



IFC Judicial Fine Resolution

Whereas, all chapters of the Interfraternity Council are to abide by the Event Management Guidelines and University Recognition Policy when hosting an event

Whereas, any chapter who violates said guidelines is subject to fair and appropriate consequences as deemed so by the Greek Judicial Board

Whereas, these consequences and punishments must fluidly change so as to reflect the gravity of such violations in the current landscape of the Greek System

Whereas, new members cannot be present at events with alcohol during the new member period, and freshmen cannot be present at events with alcohol during quarters 1-3

Be it Therefore Resolved, that the Interfraternity Council sets forth monetary penalties related to violations of the Event Management Guidelines and University Recognition Policy.

All of the following criteria will be treated on a binary (Yes/No) level to determine the total **per brother (full member)** monetary fine for violating the Event Management Guidelines and University Recognition Policy. The roster to determine the per brother fine will be according to OFSIL's records.

1. Is the event found in violation Unregistered? (Yes/No) If yes, fine = \$5 per brother
2. Does the event found in violation contain the presence of Hard Alcohol? If yes, fine = \$20 per brother
3. If alcohol is present, is the event found in violation in the presence of new members/freshmen? If yes, fine = \$5 per brother

The specific fine amounts are separate and specific to the criteria listed above. Therefore, they can reach as high as **\$30 per brother** with all criteria violated. All proceeds will be given to charity with 50% going towards the IFC's charity (United Way) and 50% going towards the violating chapter's official philanthropic charity.

NOTE: During the 4th quarter, criterion #3 does not apply and will not be enforced.

NOTE: This policy will **not** be applied to incidents retroactively.
